#### Notes

- Candidates who wish to have their dry walling skills examined for certification by The Stone Trust (in cooperation with the Dry Stone Walling Association of Great Britain) should read and fully familiarise themselves with information on The Stone Trust's website, under Certification, as well as with the DSWA booklet titled Craftsman Certification Scheme – Introduction & Schedules.
- It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure Certification Examination requirements are understood.
- The Certification Plan application Form and payment must arrive no less than one month prior to the test date. Please remember to sign the form.
- Checks should be made payable to The Stone Trust.
- Mark sheets are not issued to Examiner(s) until fees and forms have been received and processed.
- Test Days require an enrollment of at least four candidates: the group may include candidates for all four levels.
- Tests for Level III / Advanced and Level IV / Master are two part tests. Part A must be completed and passed before an application can be accepted for Part B. Since the Part A examination is not timed, work can be graded on days apart from scheduled Test Days. All Part B examinations, because they are timed, will be taken as part of a scheduled Test Day.
- Personal data will be stored in a computerized system. Information on an individual's certification level will be provided, on request, to enquirers. An individual may obtain a copy of their personal records by submitting a written request, together with a fee of \$15, to The Stone Trust.
- Refunds are not normally given unless under exceptional circumstances.
