Brand	Chisel Name	Product #	Key take away
T&H	<a href="#">Bull Point</a>	CHP1BP	Ideal for making flat sides on round stones. Longer handle stock than PKM 25.
Rebit	<a href="#">1" Tracer Chisel</a>	HM25	Halfway between a PKM25 and a wider Tracer Chisel. Removes bumps in soft stone well, and splits harder stone with the grain.
Rebit	<a href="#">1.5" Tracer Chisel</a>	RIM38-R	Best for splitting with the grain applications and general use on softer stone. Key feature is the fatter contoured grip.
T&H	<a href="#">Carbide Hand Tracer</a>	CHT1112	A go-to tool for splitting with the grain. Can be used more widely on softer stones.
Rebit	<a href="#">Carbide Tip Point</a>	PKM25	Ideal for making flat sides on round stones. Very durable carbide.
Rebit	<a href="#">Carbide Tip Point - Small</a>	PKM22	Great for detail work or for people who like smaller handstock diameter tools.
Rebit	<a href="#">1.5" Pitching tool</a>	SM40-R	Best for Rock facing and trimming flagstone. Thick handle preferred by some.
T&H	<a href="#">Mason Chipper - 1.5"</a>	CHOM1112	Most versatile chisel when dealing with hard stones. Ideal for trimming against the grain.
